## SATURDAY, MARCH 15th

**8:00 am: Goldsboro Milling, Cattle Drive,** Leaving motel, turn left, take East US 70 Hwy to Hwy 111 Intersection, turn RIGHT on Hwy 111 South. Travel about 2.5 mile to Hwy 581 intersection, turn right travel approximately 2 miles to Arrington Bridge Road, turn left travel 2.7 miles to Cattle Drive road turn right onto dirt road. Cattle operation (drive entrance marked Sleepy Creek Private Hunting Club), continue approximately 1 mile to farm site. Dr. Gary Parker will talk about mixing and feeding high nitrate hay.

**10:30 am: Leave** Goldsboro Milling Cattle Operation to Cherry Hospital Beef Unit, 201 Stevens Mill Road, Goldsboro. Turn left onto 581 North; travel 7.7 miles to Cherry Hospital stoplight. Continue straight through intersection onto Stevens Mill Road. Travel 1 mile on Stevens Mill Road to the Beef unit, which is located on the right.

**11:00am:** Cherry Hospital, Beef Unit, 201 Stevens Mill Road, Goldsboro. Dr. Wes Watson will do a presentation on Fly Control Research. Leaving the Beef Unit, turn left onto Steven Mill Road. The Research Station office will be located on the right behind the prison.

**4:30pm:** Leaving Bobcat Farm travel on Hwy 903 North to Kenansville take Hwy 11 to Pink Hill. At Pink Hill take Hwy 1704 Kitty Noecker Road go approximately one mile Panther Creek Farms will be located on the left (1434 Kitty Noecker Road).

5:00 pm: Panther Creek Farms, John Smith, tour farm. Dinner at John Smith's cow barn. Dinner sponsored by John Smith and Ivesco. Joe Hampton will give an update on EPD's.
