Directions from Asheboro: from Hwy 64 West take 220/1-73/1-74 South (do not take business 220) to Seagrove, exit 45. At stop sign, go right 1.7 miles to Old Troy Rd. Take left and go approximately 4 miles; at Y in the road, stay right. Go 3.8 miles to Blue Q Ranch.

Directions from Albemarle: take NC 24/27 to Troy. In Troy, take left on 134 North (blue brick NAPA store). Go 5.2 miles to Floyd Farm Rd, turn right , go 1.4 miles to T. Go left 1.5 miles to Blue Q Ranch.
