

Show Rules

Show Categories:

1. There will be classes for heifers, bulls, and cow calf pairs. Champions will be selected in each category. There will be no overall champion.
2. Classes will be made up after the cattle are checked in at the show.

Premiums and Awards:

1. Each entry shown shall receive a ribbon. Awards will also be presented to Champion and Reserve for each class of animals shown.

The General Rules Statement for the National Junior Angus Association will apply. The show superintendent will make the final decision on any concerns the day of the show.

The decision of the Judge is FINAL.

All animals must meet NC Health requirements and will be examined by a veterinarian on the day of arrival. Any animal exhibiting clinical signs of an infectious disease will not be allowed to show.

Exhibitors are responsible for the feeding, watering and care of their animals during the event.

Exhibitors are responsible for helping to clean and straight up the NCSU Beef Unit.
